

Pronouns, how do they work?

We use pronouns to identify ourselves and each other in conversation. It goes along with our gender identity, which is how a person feels on the inside and may or may not be how people present on the outside, called gender expression. There are many different pronouns, but below are listed the most common.

She/her/hers - These are for people who identify as female.

He/him/his - These are for people who identify as male.

They/them/theirs - These are for people who identify as something else, such as non-binary or agender.
